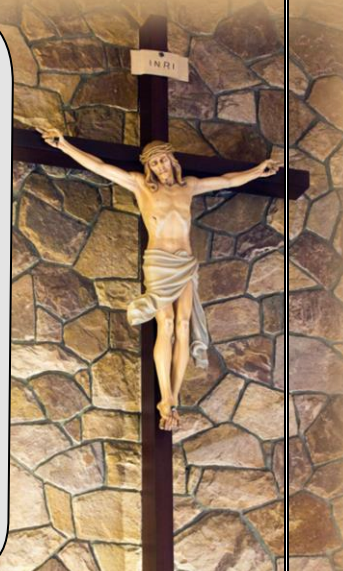

SACRAMENT PREPARATION FOR FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION: The Calgary Roman Catholic Diocese is initiating a new Diocesan Wide Sacrament Preparation program beginning fall 2018 for **First Reconciliation** and **First Communion**. Children in grade 2 and up will be prepared for and celebrate First Reconciliation **before** being prepared for First Eucharist. There are four (4) monthly sessions and a retreat to prepare for First Reconciliation, as well as four (4) monthly sessions and a retreat to prepare for First Communion beginning **Sunday, September 30 at 8:45am. Parents attend concurrent 90 minute sessions.** Children who have received **First Communion** and wish to receive the **Sacrament of First Reconciliation only** will join the First Reconciliation sessions only. **Parents will attend an Information Session Tuesday September 25 from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm.** Registration forms with a complete schedule are at the back of the church, in the office and on the website. The fee is \$25.00 per Sacrament to cover the cost of materials. The deadline for registration is September 18, 2018.
