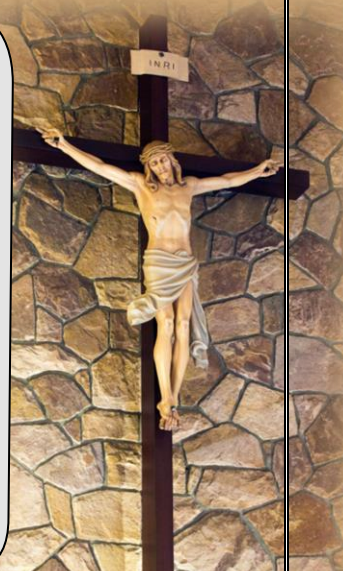

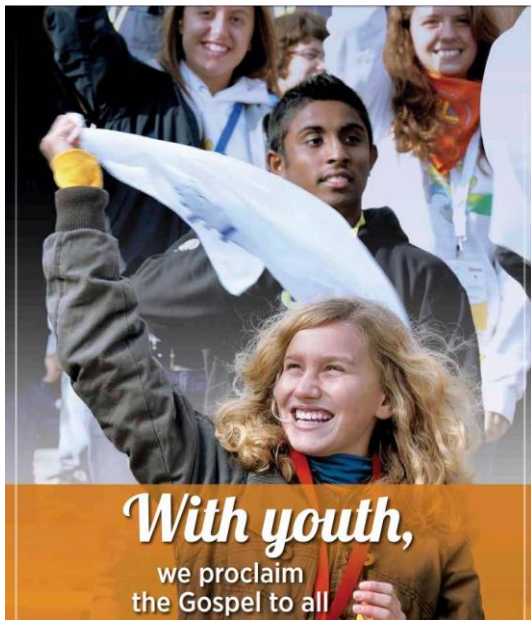
We require volunteers to participate in the candle procession in lieu of families unable to attend. Please contact Dorothy Loucks at the parish office.
