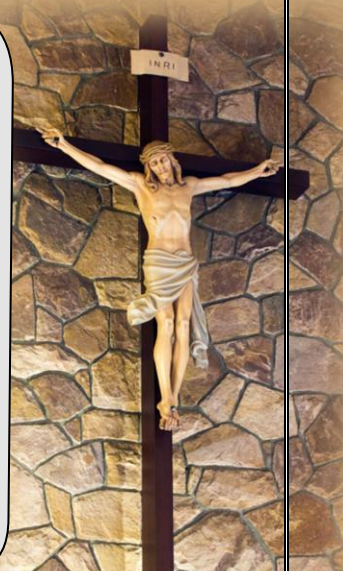

St. Cyril's Church was closed in 1997 and the statue was then placed in storage at Holy Trinity Church in Blairmore.

In 2016, the beautiful statue was donated to St. Anthony's Church, Calgary.
