You are welcome to join the celebration of Chrism Mass on Monday, April 15 at 7:30 pm. At this Mass, Bishop McGrattan blesses the oil that will be used for the oil of the sick, the oil of salvation, and the sacred chrism. This liturgy takes place shortly before the Easter Triduum because the oil of salvation and the sacred chrism will be used for the sacraments of baptism and confirmation during the Easter Vigil. During the Chrism Mass, all priests are invited to renew their commitment to service and to receive the prayerful support of the assembly.
