

## Are You As Concerned With The Recent Supreme Court Ruling Regarding Sports Wagering As I Am?

This is Angie Cretors. As a former NCAA enforcement staff member who worked in the Agent, Gambling, and Amateurism (AGA) department, I am very concerned about the possible ramifications of the recent Supreme Court ruling. This ruling could impact the integrity of every intercollegiate contest.

In addition to my work at the NCAA, I also have served as a Senior Associate Athletic Director overseeing a Compliance Office. I understand that many Compliance Offices are already taxed with current responsibilities and do not have the budget to hire additional staff to conduct educational and monitoring activities concerning sports wagering issues.

To ease the impact this ruling will have on NCAA Compliance Offices, I have created a program to reduce the likelihood of sports wagering violations that includes:

- ✓ Providing <u>educational sessions</u> to student-athletes, athletics department administrators, and other departments on campus that might deal with this issue during a two-day visit to the institution;
- Assisting the institution in developing policies and monitoring systems related to sports wagering; and
- ✓ Providing the institution with a <u>quarterly newsletter</u> that contains ideas for additional educational sessions and/or preventive measures.
