

## **Delivery Van Wagons**

The Delivery Van (a modern abbreviation of *caravan*) Wagon formed the largest group of commercial wagons. Basically a covered boxlike vehicle, being built in many sizes and styles for all types of delivery work. These attractive, platform wagons were able to be pulled by one or two horses, making them adaptable to any type of light to medium work.

Delivery Vans built with these plan-sets could be labeled for Peddlers, a Butcher, a Bakery, a Market, a Milk, an Ice Wagon or an Ambulance or used by every Huckster who sold Snake Oil medicine elixirs or even a Furniture Van.
