17.08.020(A) Prior to securing any required building permit, or construction, reconstruction alteration, improvement, modification, erection or moving in of any buildings, storage sheds, fences, decks or other types of structures within the city, the owner shall file with the City a Notice of Intent to Construct.

17.08.020(C) No building permit shall be issued by the authorized building official unless: A Notice of Intent to Construct has been filed with the City Recorder and a copy of same is presented to the authorized building official at time application for a building permit is made.

IMPORTANT: Pursuant to Metolius City Code 17.08.030, the approval of this Notice is subject to a 15-day appeal period. If an appeal of this Notice is filed your authorization to do work under this Notice and any related building permits will be temporarily suspended pending the outcome of the appeal. A successful appeal could result in the permanent suspension of your authorization to continue work until the concerns raised in the appeal are satisfactorily addressed and/or you may be required, at your own expense, to undo work already completed.
