Dogs Running at Large

No person shall allow a dog owned by him/her or under his/her control to roam the city. Any dog off or outside the premises of the owner or custodian, and not restrained by a rope, line, leash, chain or other similar means, or not under the immediate control, restraint or command of the owner or custodian, shall be considered "a dog at large". With no animal control personnel or a dog pound in Madras, Culver or Metolius, we can't seize dogs at large but this is a punishable violation of the Metolius Municipal Code 6.08.10 and will result in a citation, appearing before a judge and possible fines.
