\$45.00 each month

A five percent discount will be rewarded if you pay for six months in advance and a ten percent discount if you pay for twelve months in advance. This can be done during any month of the year.

12 month payment is \$540 with a 10% discount you pay \$486

6 month payment is \$270 with a 5% discount you pay \$256.50

You can make this payment during any month of the year. However, you must have a zero dollar balance to receiving a discount.

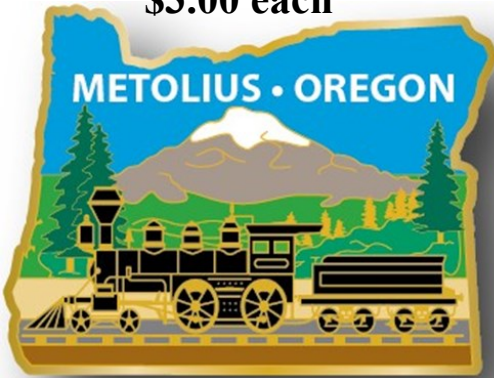
In addition, we will be having an Easter Egg Hunt, spring community clean up, Santas Workshop and the Christmas tree lighting ceremony.

Snow Removal Policy

The City of Metolius seeks to help the community in a safe and cost effective way.

- * Snow removal routes are based on the City's established priority list.
- * Snow removal on the streets will begin when the snow accumulation reaches 3 inches or more.
- * Removal of "snow berms" created by the city plow at private driveway entrances or mail boxes is the responsibility of the business or resident.
- * City plow operators will clear driveway entrances and mailbox accesses for the disabled and the elderly (defined as 62 and older). Residents that fall into these categories can call the City Hall or the Public Works Supervisor.

First priority streets/routes include:

The City Hall parking lot, Butte, Hood, Wilson, Adams, Jefferson, Washington and 9th street.

Second priority streets/routes include:

5th street, 6th street, residual collector streets in a loop pattern for efficiency, snow berms, intersections and general cleanup of residential streets.
