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# **Designated Competent Person Acknowledgement Form**

### **Definition**

A Competent Person is a person who has the ability and has been reasonably trained to recognize hazards and has the authority to correct them. The designated competent persons must be on site during the shift or a qualified person identified by the designated competent person to assume the responsibilities and authorities must be on site during their absence from the site.

## Responsibility

The designated Competent Person is responsible for recognizing and correcting safety hazards. This person has the authority to stop work in the event of any potential safety concern on the job site. This representative is considered the contact person on safety related issues and shall be on site full time when hazard exists.

This form must be completed by the superintendent and the superintendent's designated Competent Person(s). Where a superintendent is responsible for multiple crafts, it is necessary to maintain additional designated Competent Persons and forms for each additional tier.
