#### Vote



- ⇒ Elections will take place on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 from 6:30am—3:00pm at Palo Verde High School.
- ⇒ Eligible voters are any parent or guardian with a student currently enrolled at PVHS—multiple students enrolled does not equal multiple votes.

### **Attend Monthly Meetings**



The principal will send out meeting information at least three days in advance. All meetings will include a time for public comment, and we encourage all parents to attend. Parents and community members who are not employees of the Clark County School District will not be defended by the District if a lawsuit is filed against you because of what you say or do while participating as part of the school organizational team.

#### What is the role of the School Organizational Team?

- Provide input on the school performance plan and budget.
- Provide continued advice to the principal in carrying out the school plan.
- Assist with the selection of the next principal when there is a vacancy.

## What are the requirements of Team members?

- Attending training.
- Serve on the team through September 30, 2020, unless your child no longer attends the school.
- Attend meetings at least once per month, outside of school hours.
- Make decisions with the whole school population in mind.
- Work collaboratively and attempt to reach consensus with the team.
