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## Homeownership Information

River City Habitat for Humanity helps make homeownership attainable and affordable for homebuyers who may not currently qualify for a conventional mortgage. Through the Homeownership Program, families are empowered to become successful homeowners by gaining hands-on construction experience and by attending homeownership classes. Completion of the program can take 12-18 months. As a Partner Family, you will then purchase your house through an affordable 20 – 25 year mortgage loan.

Habitat for Humanity has three criteria for selection:

1. **Housing Need.** Current housing is inadequate, substandard, or unaffordable.
2. **Ability to Pay.**
  - ✓ Applicant(s) must have a reliable, steady and verifiable source of income.
  - ✓ Credit history shows ability to repay the loan.
  - ✓ Applicant(s) income is between 30% to 60% of the HUD area median income \*\*\*
  - ✓ U.S. citizenship or permanent resident status is valid.
3. **Willingness to Partner.** Families will partner with River City Habitat in several important ways.
  - ✓ Sweat Equity: 350 hours (for one applicant) or 450 hours (for two applicants), which is about 20 hours a month. Sweat equity can be earned by working on the construction job sites, working at the Habitat ReStore and other special events.
  - ✓ Applicant(s) must complete a series of educational classes, including a mandatory budgeting class.
  - ✓ Applicant(s) must provide all necessary documents during the application process.
  - ✓ Applicant(s) must be willing to purchase a Habitat home and make regular monthly mortgage payments for a 20 – 25 year mortgage.

*\*\*\* Income Guidelines: Numbers are from HUD Income Limits, 2018, Cole County area. The household's GROSS monthly income (before taxes and deductions) should fall in the following range:*
