



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Won't the County charge for 911 services?

Charging for 911 is based on the fact that the City of Lincoln has a Police Dept. and Fire Dept. that receive 911 calls. The City is thus required by the state to have 911 dispatching, and they contracted with the County many years ago for that service, currently at \$56,000 per year. The Town would not have any groups that would receive 911 calls, and thus won't be required to have, or pay for, 911 service.
