New Ice Rules

Public Sessions

Reminders of public session rules:

- Freestyle moves (i.e. jumps and spins) will be allowed on public session Monday through Friday ONLY, and only if there are fewer than 50 skaters on the ice.
- No Jumps and spins on weekend public sessions.
- If there are fewer than 10 skaters, freestyle skaters can practice on the full ice.
- If there are 11-50 skaters, the middle will be coned off and freestyle moves may be practiced only in the coned off area.
- If there are more than 50 skaters, no freestyle moves allowed.
- NO camel spins or spirals allowed at any time.
