

Four people are arrested after officers respond to a fight where guns were involved.

According to the Madison Police Department, on April 9 at approximately 2:10 p.m. officers responded to a reported fight in progress, with guns, in the 170 block of Taft Drive. Upon arrival officers located the parties involved, and they allegedly became verbally combative as officers attempted to seize a handgun which was reportedly displayed during the altercation.

As officers attempted to take Ta'Juan Manning and Ta'Shawn Manning, both of Madison, into custody, both resisted. Officers deployed their Tasers and were ultimately able to take both Mannings into custody.

Two females on the scene, Kayla Jones and Chelsea Baxter, both of Madison, interfered with officers and were arrested as well. Jones allegedly battered a patrolman as she struck him about the head while he was attempting to take Ta'juan Manning into custody. The officer received minor injuries and was treated by EMS.

All four subjects face charges for Disorderly Conduct and Interference with an Officer's Duties. Both Mannings and Jones face an additional charge of Resisting Law Enforcement, and Ta'Juan Manning and Kayla Jones face an additional charge of Battery on a Public Safety Official.

The investigation into the incident is ongoing. During the follow-up investigation, officers seized an assault rifle that was also reportedly displayed during the original altercation.
