SZ PM Consultants, Inc. was selected to process DDOT public space permit applications for the 2.6 billion-dollar DC Clean Rivers (DCCR) CSO Tunnel Program under the Anacostia Waterfront Initiative (AWI) Program as a subconsultant to the AWI Program Management team prime, CH2M. We processed well over 1,300 DDOT public space permit applications for the DCCR CSO program.

In May of 2015, our firm was once again retained to process DDOT public space permit applications for the 250 to 300 million dollars CSX Virginia Avenue Tunnel Project. We processed over 150 DDOT public space permit applications for the CSX Virginia Avenue Tunnel Project.



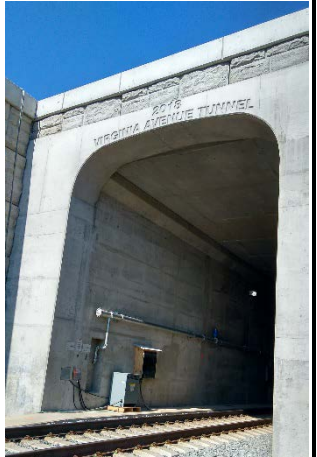
Both tunnel programs, located in the public space in the District, require a significant effort in project coordination, design reviews, and approvals by DDOT.

During the permitting process for the DCCR CSO Tunnel Program, we collaborated with applicants and reviewers within DDOT and other government agencies, such as DOEE and DC Water; utility companies, such as PEPCO and Washington Gas; and third-party reviewers. We also coordinated design reviews for major design submittal packages so that DDOT's comments were addressed prior to the permit application process in order to expedite the permit approval process, thereby, meeting the project schedule under the EPA consent decree.

A brief summary of those two ongoing mega projects is presented below:

**DCCR CSO Tunnel Program** - The DCCR CSO Program is an activity of DC Water's Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP). The LTCP is required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to reduce pollution from combined sewer overflows to Rock Creek, Anacostia River, and Potomac River. In achieving this goal, DC Water is implementing the \$2.6 billion Clean Rivers Project. The project is underway and involves the construction of a massive underground tunnel system to control combined sewer overflows to the Anacostia River. Green infrastructures are being implemented as a tool to reduce combined sewer overflows to the Potomac River and Rock Creek. Green infrastructure technologies mimic natural processes by capturing, slowing, and cleaning stormwater before it enters DC Water's combined sewer system.

**CSX Virginia Avenue Tunnel Project** - The existing Virginia Avenue Tunnel is a 110-year old, 3,800-foot passage that is nearing the end of its useful life. The tunnel houses a single train track immediately beneath Virginia Avenue in southeast DC. Trains enter and exit the tunnel from the west side, near 2<sup>nd</sup> Street SE, and on the east side, near 11<sup>th</sup> Street SE. This tunnel project is meant to increase the tunnel width to install a second track and raise the height of the tunnel roof to make room for double-stack intermodal container trains.
