Off-Highway Vehicles


The use of ATV's or any off-highway vehicles are prohibited in Morinville.

RV and Trailer Parking

All trailers must remain attached to their towing vehicle when parked on any roadway. Unattached trailers are not permitted to be on the road at any time.

Recreational vehicles and trailers cannot cross or impede any part of a sidewalk. Recreational vehicles may be parked on a premises and shall follow all conditions of the Community Standards Bylaw 13/2017.

Where allowed, all vehicles parked in a yard must be done so on an approved hard surfaced parking area.

Seconds count in a fire emergency and advanced warning from smoke alarms and an effective home fire escape plan could save your life.

- Have at least one smoke alarm on every level of your home & test the alarms monthly.
- For each room in your house, identify two exits for escape.
- Draw a simple floor plan of your home, clearly mark exits and practice at least twice a year.
- Keep a telephone, emergency phone numbers, glasses, wheelchair/walker/cane, medications, flashlight, and a whistle near your bed in case of an emergency.
- Adapt your fire escape plans to the individuals in your house.
- Assign a designated helper for any person in your house who may need assistance in a fire emergency.


EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT


Early Childhood Development is an opportunity for children aged 2-6 to participate in a social setting, develop new friends, and feel safe within the play area. Morinville offers programs with purpose and intent to provide the highest quality Early Childhood programming to our residents. Utilizing the Early Development Instrument standardizes the measurements of development of children based on social, emotional, physical and intellectual development.

The developmental domains are:



Physical Health & Well Being Encouraging physical growth and independence, gross







Encourage age-appropriate emotional understanding, empathy, reflection, controlled actions (thinking before doing).



anguage & Thinking

Encouraging reading, writing, and classification of shapes, numbers, colours, sizes and concepts.



Communication Skills & General Knowledge

Encourage open communication of needs and wants in a socially appropriate way, storytelling and an appropriate awareness of the outside world.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Youth development program supports building assets within our youth for a stronger community. The goal of the youth workers are to support youth that live in Morinville by engaging them in healthy activities and working with them to increase their connections to the community. The youth workers develop programs that encourage assets development through:

One on One Youth Support working with the youth to connect them to resources, help them deal with challenges and provide referrals where necessary.

Community Education offers opportunities to youth, parents and community agencies to build their skills in communication, working with youth and supporting friendly youth environments.

Youth Leadership Program offers youth to opportunity to be empowered, build their skills, develop community connections, volunteer and develop leaders for the future.

Bullying Prevention Program on National Pink Shirt Day is an opportunity to show our support and stand up to bullying by wearing pink. Morinville FCSS is dedicated to the education and prevention of bullying in Morinville.
