GUIDELINES — Please Read & Follow

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to amateur and professional artists
 - ◆ The exhibition is selected from actual physical work
 - ♦ Entries may be up to 48" x 48" including frame & 50 lbs.
 - All entries must be produced in the past three years, not previously entered or shown at the Museum
- 2. FEE: The entry fee of \$30 per work is not refundable
- 3. PRESENTATION:
 - ♦ All wall-referenced work must be suitably wired, framed and prepared for hanging no sawtooth or D-ring hangers, and no metal frames with wire attached to sliding clips will be accepted; gallery wrap canvas with painted sides or with banded edges are permitted—but no staples can show on the sides
 - Wiring instructions: apex of wire must be 3" below frame or stretcher bar top; do not double wrap wire
 - Please be sure that all matting, frame, and glass are clean, sturdy, and professional; do not tape artwork to frame
- 4. SALES: The Museum will retain a 25% commission from pieces sold; this must be included in the price given for each piece
 - Works submitted without a price will be listed as not for sale

5. SUBMISSION:

- Artist's name, address, phone number, title of artwork, category, and price must be firmly affixed to back of each submission prior to entry (DO NOT ATTACH ENTRY FORM)
- No artist may remove work from the Museum during the exhibition. No exceptions. Accepted work pick up is Nov 17-18.

ENTRY & JUDGING

- If your entry is accepted your name and the title will be listed on the Museum's website no later than 5 PM, Friday, October 12. The Museum will also post on social media. Staff WILL NOT make calls regarding acceptance status; please check the website, do not call the Museum.
- If your title is not listed, the judges did not select your entry.
 Entries that are not accepted may be picked up from the Museum beginning Sunday, October 14.
- Jury selection is at the sole discretion of the judges; the Museum reserves the right to reject any work that is not presented according to these guidelines or for any reasonable concern.
- All entrants receive comp admission to the opening reception on Saturday, October 13 from 5-8 pm, and may bring one (1) guest; no pick ups of non-accepted entries during the reception.

FAQ — Please Read Before Entering

What is OIL / ACRYLIC?

Painting in oil or alkyd, or acrylic-based opaque media that does not require glass or plexiglass to protect the surface.

What is WATERCOLOR / WATER-BASED MEDIA?

Transparent watercolor, gouache, ink, acrylic handled like watercolor, and presented on watercolor paper or board. Must be framed under glass or plexiglass.

What is VARIED TECHNIQUES?

This is most media categories that are *not* Oil/Acrylic, Watercolor, or Three-Dimensional. It may include but is not limited to: mixed media, pastel, graphite, printmaking, graphics, collage, or computergenerated imagery. If it is not one of those examples, describe it on the entry form. If there could be issues or concerns, please call us for clarification before entering something in a medium not listed here.

What is THREE-DIMENSIONAL?

Works entered in the 3-D category may include but are not limited to wood, clay/ceramics, stone, metal, jewelry, fiber, or assemblage. There is a 50 lb. weight limit, and the competition size restrictions also apply. It is always best to call before entering to discuss any particular technical qualities or aspects that could affect its presentation.

Why is Photography not allowed in Best of the Best?

Photography as a distinctive medium is the exclusive focus of our spring juried competition and exhibition *Through the Eye of the Camera*. Please consider entering your photography-based works of art then.
