### East Nottingham Township Planning Commission Meeting Minutes August 27, 2007

The regular meeting of the East Nottingham Township Planning Commission was held in the Township Building on August 27, 2007 at 7:00 pm. Those present were: Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr., Vice-Chairperson, Clifford Lee, Planning Commission Members Gene Turns, John Wallace, Walt Leis, Janice Gavin and Planning Commission Secretary, PJ Scheese. Members Mike Rebert was absent.

Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr., called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr. asked Vice-Chairperson, Clifford Lee to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Joe Bauer said that PC member Marianne Russo resigned for health reasons. He then introduced the newest member of the PC, Janice Gavin.

#### Subdivisions & Land Development Plans

Joe Bauer reviewed the PC meeting Protocol for Township Engineer Review Letters:

#### Township Engineer Review Letters

#### Elkdale Green - Preliminary Subdivision Plan

Jim Gade reviewed his letter. There are 84 single family homes proposed for 69.3 acres bordering Oxford & Little Elk Creek Roads. There are some minor technical issues, along with the open space & sanitary sewer issue. Jim Gade is working with the applicant on these.

Cliff Lee asked about the sewer issues with the Oxford Area Sewer Authority, who is requiring 100% replacement area for the drip field, which would end up decreasing the number of lots. Walt Leis stated that his company, T. C. Inc., has done some initial soils testing and therefore, he is recusing himself from voting on anything regarding this subdivision.

The bio-retention facilities is another issue that still needs to be worked out. They are located next to recreational areas. The applicant still needs to come in front of the Township to explain the retention areas and what they are doing with them.

A motion was made by Cliff Lee, seconded by John Wallace, to take no action. The motion carried. Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Abstain: 1 (Walt Leis)

#### Reserves of Dunlap

Laura Swiski, of Lake Roeder Hillard, represented the applicant. The Transferable Development Rights to be used for this subdivision are coming from Jacob & Hannah Stoltzfus's property on Mount Olivet Road. The issue addressed was regarding Section 1403.C of the Zoning Ordinance, the certification of available TDRs.

The Stoltzfuses was requesting the Township make a determination and certification of the number of development rights available on their property. Jim Gade, Township Engineer, had reviewed Lot 2 of the tract and agrees with Laura Swiski's calculations of 49 before the 10% bonus, and 54 with the 10% bonus. This bonus is granted when all TDRs are purchased from a particular tract. The Reserves of Dunlap will not use all TDRs. Jim Gade said he would issue a letter, using the current ordinance

A motion was made by Walt Leis, seconded by John Wallace, to pass on Jim Gade's letter, with the recommendation that the BOS approve those calculations. The motion carried.

- Walt Leis would like to request the BOS have a workshop or forum to discuss where and how each
  of the sewer systems proposed by the various subdivisions are going to be integrated into the
  overall sewer system. Jim Gade stated that he has asked this questions of the developers himself,
  but they do not seem to be sure themselves yet. There was some further discussion of this.
- Joe Bauer stated that last Wednesday night, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, there was another meeting at Lower Oxford Township to discuss the multi-municipality comprehensive plan. Present were representatives of Lower Oxford, Upper Oxford, Borough of Oxford, West Nottingham, and East

representatives of Lower Oxford, Upper Oxford, Borough of Oxford, West Nottingham, and East Nottingham. He said it was a good session, where they discussed an outline for the municipalities to join in a regional comprehensive plan. Ninety percent of the cost is covered by the county. Each municipality will only have to pay about \$1000. Following meetings will be held on the fourth Wednesday of each month at the Lower Oxford Township building at 7:00 pm. They are looking for one volunteer from each municipality's Board of Supervisors and one from each Planning Commission.
