

NOTICE OF CONDITIONAL USE HEARING

The Board of Supervisors of East Nottingham Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania will hold a hearing on Monday, July 15, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Building located at 158 Election Road, Oxford, Pennsylvania 19363 to consider the conditional use application of Chester County Food Bank for property owned by Paul Andriole and Robert Bakalez trading as Canterbury Acres Associates located at 992 and 1000 Hickory Hill Road, partially located in East Nottingham Township and partially located in the Borough of Oxford further identified as UPI Numbers 69-3-65.4 and 69-3-76.3 and 6-10-2.1. That portion located in East Nottingham Township is in the C-1 Special Limited Business Zoning District.

Applicant seeks a conditional use under the provisions of Section 27-902.1.C(3) in the form of a planned village commercial center. Applicant proposes to construct an approximate 30,000 square foot building and associated parking and improvements. The village commercial center would consist of a food store, business and professional offices, a trade school and medical and dental clinic.
