RULES AND REGULATIONS (*Visit Website for more details*)

All rules in the Provincial Syllabus apply unless modified or expanded by a local rule.

Non-competitive participants receive adjudication but no mark.

For competitive classes marks will be written on the adjudication sheet.

For music entries photocopies are permitted only with the publisher's consent and proof of such presented to committee ***in advance of*** session.

For Speech Arts, AMAF has been able to purchase a license which allows photocopies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SOLO AWARDS/TROPHIES/SCHOLARSHIPS (*Website has more information*)

Speech Arts A participant must perform competitively in two solo classes at their grade level, one of which must be chosen from the Speech Arts Suggested Repertoire Lists. A mark of at least 80% is required in both classes.

Vocal Classes TWO SELECTIONS, one of which must be a piece from the Repertoire/Resource List, must be performed competitively and a mark of 80% must be attained. (Exception: vocal ages 6 and under. See below.)

Vocal ages 6 and under: As there are no pieces listed on the repertoire/Resource lists, participants may be eligible for awards if they enter two own choice solo selections competitively and attain a mark of 80%.

Piano Classes TWO SELECTIONS, one of which must be from a class listed as on the Piano Addendum, must be performed competitively and a mark of 80% attained. (These are equivalent to the former "test piece" classes.)

Instrumental & Strings Classes To be eligible for a solo award a performer must play competitively in at least two solo classes at the same level. A mark of at least 80% must be attained by the winner of the class.

Dance Classes To be eligible a mark of at least 80% must be attained.

Adult Entries are welcome. They will be listed separately in the program so adults and children/youth are not competing against each other.

Copies of Selections for the adjudicator: Music participants (piano, vocal, choral, instrumental) and speech arts participants must supply copies from their respective Repertoire/Resource Lists and Own Choice selections for the adjudicator.

The Deloraine Border Festival, may, at its discretion, create a class in any discipline where an entry warrants. The Deloraine Border Festival may, at its discretion, cancel a class where enough entries are not received to justify the hiring of an adjudicator.

ALL AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIP/TROPHY RECIPIENTS ARE CHOSEN BY THE ADJUDICATORS

All performers, if called upon, should be prepared to perform at the Festival Awards Concert.

Complaints/Concerns Do not approach the adjudicator.

A written complaint or concern should be forwarded to the festival secretary.

Mary Jo Carrabré is known for her quiet demeanor and dedication to work as a musician, performer, teacher and administrator. As an educator, Ms Carrabré has a distinct approach in her teaching style that is both engaging and empowering.

As the Brandon Centre Representative for the Royal Conservatory of Music Examinations, Mary Jo has become a recognizable and calming influence for the young exam candidates. She is also sought after as an adjudicator at music festivals throughout Canada, most recently for the Tempo, Thompson and the Canadian Music Competition. These roles bring Mary Jo into contact with thousands of young musicians each year. "Music can play a vital role in how they mature and develop."

Mary Jo is in her 17th year as the Director of the Eckhardt-Gramatté Conservatory of Music at Brandon University. "I feel very privileged to serve in this position and I'm thankful to my colleagues for their encouragement and expertise. We are all proud of the quality of music instruction we provide".

Mary Jo holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Manitoba where she studied with the late Marek Jablonski and a Master of Music degree from the University of Western Ontario.

Mary Jo is also active on a number of boards, including the Eckhardt-Gramatté National Music Competition. "This great organization brings our young Canadian artists to the national stage."

Ms. Carrabré enjoys her active musical life, loves entertaining her friends and colleagues and looks forward to meeting new challenges that lie ahead.

PIANO AWARDS OFFERED

ALL Awards by Recommendation of the Adjudicator

SOLO AWARDS

To be eligible for a solo award a performer must play competitively at least two solo selections, one of which must be from a class as listed on the "special addendum for piano". A mark of at least 80% must be attained by the winner of the class (from Grade 1 and up). *Eligibility may be affected if an entry is withdrawn or changed.*

The adjudicator will choose the top performance.

Award winners must advance to next grade the following year in order to be eligible for an award that year with the exception of Beginner and Grade 9 and up. (see details in this regard below)

An award will be presented to the top performance in:

Beginner Piano: Two awards as long as entry numbers allow. If entry numbers are down in a particular year it will up to the discretion of the festival committee to commit to only one award.

Age split for this award will change from year to year according to number of entries received which will dictate the two groups.

- Award winner 7 years and older must advance to Grade 1 the following year.
- Award winner 6 years old may play competitively in Beginner category one more year, previous year repertoire may NOT be repeated.
- Award winner 5 years old may play competitively in Beginner category two more years, previous years repertoire may NOT be repeated.

A student may only enter competitively in the Beginner classes for a maximum of three years, regardless of whether or not they have received an award. After that, entry must be non-competitive in the Beginner classes.

One Award in each: Grade 1 Grade 2 Grade 3 Grade 4 Grade 5 Grade 6
Grade 7 (Scholarship) Grade 8 (Scholarship)
Grade 9 (Scholarship) Grade 10 (Scholarship) Grade 11 and Honors (Scholarship)

Levels 9 and up – Award winners will remain eligible the following year at same level but may NOT repeat previous year repertoire. (*Rationale: It is expected these grade levels usually require a minimum of two years to complete.*)

OTHER SOLO AWARDS

Jazz (Blues, Boogie & Rag) Scholarship - Class K 4000

Participants in this class may be eligible for the Jazz piano award by playing a jazz piece, plus another solo piece from the addendum list, and obtaining a mark of over 80%

- ❖ Scholarship (Beginner to Senior)

Canadian / Manitoba Composer Scholarships

Works by Canadian Composers must be entered in the Canadian Composers class. This is as stated in the Provincial Syllabus 2010 Edition – Summary of Changes.

Two awards are offered as long as entries allow. It will be up to discretion of festival committee to adjust number of awards and to split levels according to entries submitted in a particular year.

- ❖ One for Beginner – Gr 3
- ❖ One for Grade 4 - Senior

National Anthem Award - Class K 1000

Participants in this class may be eligible for this award by playing a national anthem piece, plus another solo piece from the addendum list, and obtaining a mark of over 80%

DUET or TRIO MEDALLION

Medallion offered as award in duet / trio classes

To be eligible for a medallion a mark of at least 80% is required

Geraldine Kroeker Memorial Scholarship (Grades 3 and Up)

This is an award of excellence for a duet or trio performance Grade 3 up to and including Senior Level. To be eligible, a mark of at least 80% is required and all performers must have also played at least one solo piece competitively, which must be from the Resource List. RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR.

MAJOR SOLO AWARDS

Brandon & Westman Registered Music Teachers Assoc Scholarship

This award is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR. To be eligible a performer must meet the criteria set for solo awards. This is an award of excellence for a solo performance up to and including Grade 6.

Southwest Assiniboine Chapter of Retired Teachers Association Scholarship

This is an award of excellence for solo performance in Piano. RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR and each performer must meet the criteria set for solo awards.

Claudia Franklin Memorial Scholarship (Grades 4-7)

This is an award for outstanding contribution to the festival. Consideration will be given to the number of entries a student has made and the standard at which they have performed those pieces. RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR.

Anna Franklin Memorial Scholarship (Grades 7 and up)

This award is recommended by the adjudicator. To be eligible a performer must meet the criteria set for solo awards. This is an award of excellence for a piano solo performance Grades 7 and up.

TUDOR BOWL

This is the MAJOR AWARD of EXCELLENCE to recognize the top performer in the piano discipline. RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR. To be eligible a performer must play at least two solo pieces competitively and receive a mark of at least 80%

THE DELORAINÉ FESTIVAL COMMITTEE IS **NOT** RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SUPPLYING OF MUSIC. INDIVIDUAL ENTRANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN MUSIC AS WELL AS THE ADJUDICATOR COPY AND COMPLIANCE WITH ANY AND ALL MUSIC COPYRIGHT LAWS.
