

RULES AND REGULATIONS (Visit Website for more details)

All rules in the Provincial Syllabus apply unless modified or expanded by a local rule.

Non-competitive participants receive adjudication but no mark.

For competitive classes marks will be written on the adjudication sheet.

For music entries (piano, vocal, choral) Xeroxed copies are permitted only with the publisher's consent and proof of such presented to committee *in advance of* session.

For Speech Arts, AMAF has been able to purchase a licence which allows photocopies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SOLO AWARDS/TROPHIES/SCHOLARSHIPS (Website has more information)

<u>Speech Arts and Vocal Classes</u> – TWO SELECTIONS, one of which must be a PIECE from the REPERTOIRE/RESOURCE LIST, must be performed competitively and a mark of 80% must be attained. (Exception: vocal ages 6 and under. See below.)

Vocal ages 6 and under: As there are no pieces listed on the repertoire/Resource lists, participants may be eligible for awards if they enter two own choice solo selections competitively and attain a mark of 80%.

<u>Piano Classes</u> - TWO SELECTIONS, one of which must be from a class listed as on the Piano Addendum, must be performed competitively and a mark of 80% attained. (These are equivalent to the former "test piece" classes.)

<u>Adult entries</u> are welcome. They will be listed separately in the program so that adults and children/youth are not competing against each other.

<u>Copies of selections</u> for the adjudicator: Music participants (piano, vocal, choral) must supply copies from their respective Repertoire/Resource Lists and Own Choice selections for the adjudicator. Speech Arts participants must supply copies of Own Choice selections.

The Deloraine Border Festival, may, at its discretion, create a class in any discipline where an entry warrants. The Deloraine Border Festival may, at its discretion, cancel a class where enough entries are not received to justify the hiring of an adjudicator.

ALL AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIP/TROPHY RECIPIENTS ARE CHOSEN BY THE ADJUDICATORS

All performers, if called upon, should be prepared to perform at the Hi-Lites Concert.

Complaints/Concerns Do not approach the adjudicator.

A written complaint or concern should be forwarded to the festival secretary.

Maryanne Rumancik ARCT (piano pedagogy), BA (4 year) in music composition, Bachelor of Music Therapy, as well as private in studies composition and orchestration with Dr. David Scott of Winnipeg for two years.

Ms. Rumancik lives in Lorette, MB where she has had an active piano teaching studio since 1989; teaching all ages and styles of music. She has prepared students for Royal Conservatory and Conservatory Canada exams, as well as festivals and university auditions. In addition she has been active as an accompanist, adjudicator, clinician and part – time church choir director, as well as past editor of *Take Note*, the journal for the Manitoba Registered Music Teachers' Association.

As a music therapist, Ms. Rumancik utilizes a variety of musical styles in her work with people living with developmental disabilities across the life span. She also enjoys working with elderly living in long-term care. In her music therapy work, Ms. Rumancik uses piano, guitar, voice and a variety of percussion instruments.

Ms. Rumancik has written music for piano teaching, along with choral, vocal and chamber music. Her music has received performances across Canada and internationally. Several of her junior piano pieces (*Fun for Two, Butterfly, Wish Upon a Star, Prairie Steeples, Creaky Chorale* and *Will Someone Please Play*) have been recently published by the Canadian National Conservatory's *Northern Lights* series through Mayfair/Montgomery Music. A variety of her works are available from Prairie Sky Music Publishing. In her spare time, she enjoys relaxing with family and cat, reading, gardening and biking.

PIANO AWARDS OFFERED 2014

ALL Awards by Recommendation of the Adjudicator

Deloraine Border Festival Scholarship to Arts & Music Camp - \$200

Award will be made at the recommendation of the adjudicator from applications submitted.

1. Solo Awards:

To be eligible for a solo award a performer must play competitively at least two solo selections, one of which must be from a class as listed on the "special addendum for piano". A mark of at least 80% must be attained by the winner of the class (from Grade 1 and up). The adjudicator will choose the top performance. Award winners must advance to next grade the following year in order to be eligible for an award that year.

Beginner Piano – *two awards*. Age split for this award will change from year to year according to number of entries received which will dictate the two groups. The award winner from the older group must advance to Grade 1 the following year. The award winner from the younger group may play in the beginner category for one more year.

Grade 2 Grade 7 (Scholarship)
Grade 3 Grade 8 (Scholarship)
Grade 4 Grade 9 (Scholarship)
Grade 5 Grade 10 (Scholarship)

Other Solo Awards in Piano:

Jazz (Blues, Boogie & Rag) Award Class K 4000

Participants in this class may be eligible for the Jazz piano award by playing a jazz piece, plus another solo piece from the addendum list, and obtaining a mark of over 80%

- Medallion (Beginner)
- Scholarship (Grade 1 to Senior)

Canadian / Manitoba Composer Scholarships: Three awards are offered, split determined by number of entries received each year.

- One for Beginner
- One for Grade 1 Grade 4
- One for Grade 5 Senior

National Anthem Award Class K 1000 - One Award

2. Duet / Trio Awards:

Geraldine Kroeker Memorial Scholarship (Grades 3 and Up)

This is an award of excellence for a duet *or* trio performance Grade 3 up to and including Senior Level. To be eligible, a mark of at least 80% is required and all performers must have also played at least one solo piece competitively, which must be from the Resource List. This award is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR.

One Medallion award offered in duet/trio classes
To be eligible for a medallion a mark of at least 80% is required.

3. Major Solo Awards

Brandon & Westman Registered Music Teachers Assoc Scholarship

This award is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR. To be eligible a performer must meet the criteria set for solo awards. This is an award of excellence for a solo performance up to and including Grade 6. The grades eligible for this award will change from year to year according to the number of entries which dictates the venue. Recipients of this award will be chosen from grades that perform at the Theatre.

Southwest Assiniboine Chapter of Retired Teachers Association Scholarship

This is an award of excellence for solo performance in Piano. This award is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR and each performer must meet the criteria set for solo awards.

Claudia Franklin Memorial Scholarship (Grades 4-7)

This is an award for outstanding contribution to the festival. Consideration will be given to the number of entries a student has made and the standard at which they have performed those pieces. This award is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR.

Tudor Bowl

This is the MAJOR AWARD of EXCELLENCE to recognize the top performer in the piano discipline. This is RECOMMENDED by the ADJUDICATOR. To be eligible a performer must play at least two solo pieces competitively and receive a mark of at least 80%.
