Rules and Information Regarding Scholarship:

1. Applicant must be a student age 10 on January 1st of current camp year.
2. Recipient may attend a summer arts or music camp of their choice in any genre of their choice.
3. Parents or guardians of recipient must be prepared to pay balance of required tuition, as well as be responsible for his/her transportation and other expenses.
4. Amount of Scholarship \$200.00 but subject to change at the Festival Committee's discretion.
5. A certificate acknowledging recipient has been recommended to receive the Scholarship will be presented at the Awards Concert. Scholarship will be issued upon proof of registration and must be used in current year of application or in year immediately following application.
6. The award will be made at the recommendation of the adjudicator.
