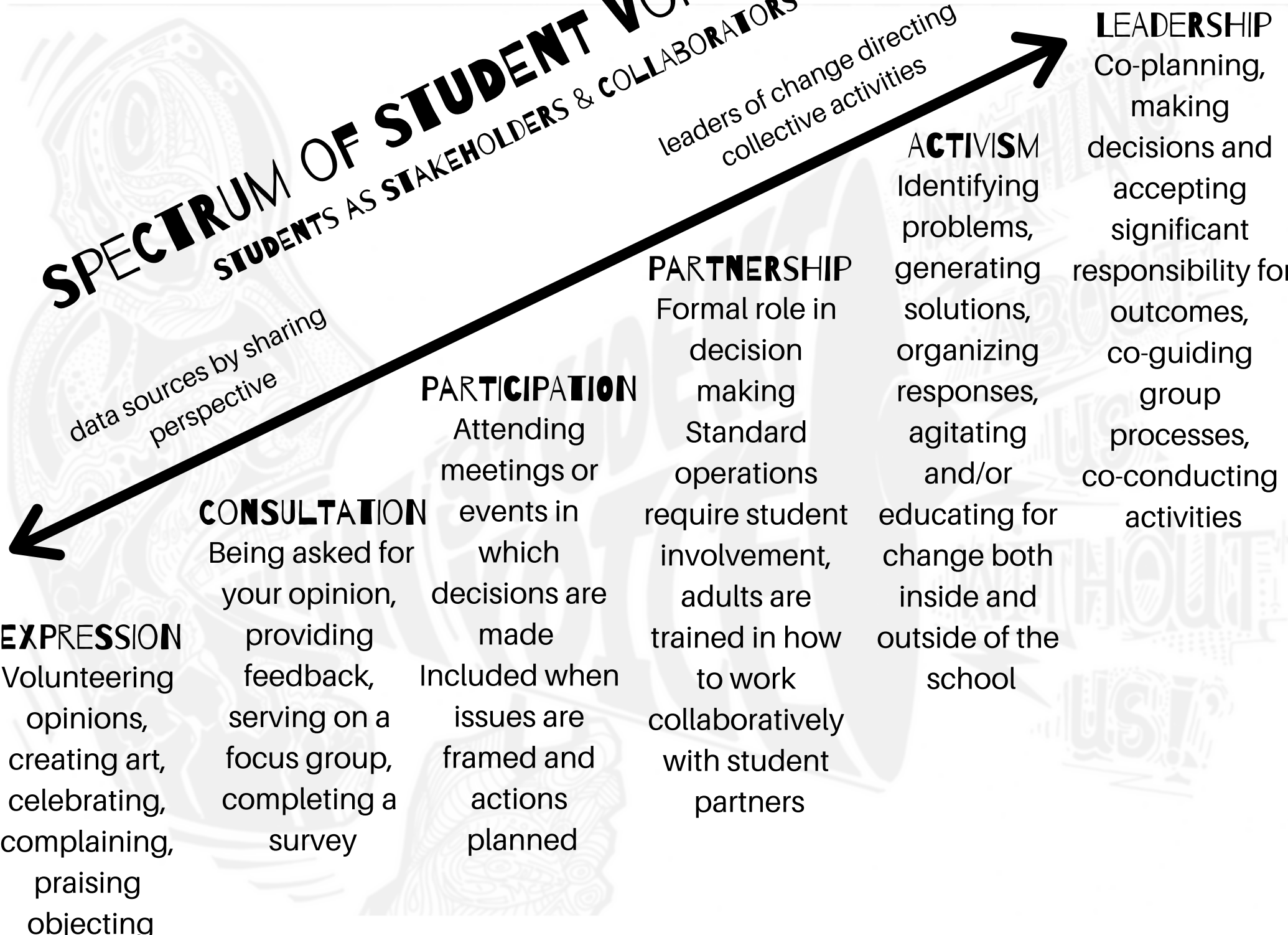


SPECTRUM OF STUDENT VOICE

EXPRESSION
Volunteering opinions, creating art, celebrating, complaining, praising objecting

CONSULTATION
Being asked for your opinion, providing feedback, serving on a focus group, completing a survey

PARTICIPATION
Attending meetings or events in which decisions are made
Included when issues are framed and actions planned

PARTNERSHIP
Formal role in decision making
Standard operations require student involvement, adults are trained in how to work collaboratively with student partners

ACTIVISM
Identifying problems, generating solutions, organizing responses, agitating and/or educating for change both inside and outside of the school

LEADERSHIP
Co-planning, making decisions and accepting significant responsibility for outcomes, co-guiding group processes, co-conducting activities
