**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELDOVIA, ALASKA
PROVIDING COMMENT FOR THE PROPOSED PEBBLE PROJECT, PERMIT
APPLICATION POA-2017-271, U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS REGULATORY
DIVISION, ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT**

WHEREAS: the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Regulatory Division received application POA-2017-271 Pebble Limited Project, December 01, 2017; and

WHEREAS: the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Regulatory Division requests public input regarding the scope of the environmental impact; and

WHEREAS: the salmon runs are an intricate and vital part of the Alaskan and Seldovian economy, culture and overall way of life; and

WHEREAS: the Seldovia fishing families of Bristol Bay and all the fishermen of Bristol Bay and the Cook Inlet would be economical devastated should any damage occur to the world renowned fishery of Bristol Bay; and

WHEREAS: it is requested that alternative port sites be evaluated due to the potential ecological impact from the project to Bristol Bay fisheries and their families; and

WHEREAS: alternative fuel sources be evaluated in an effort to eliminate the potential long term consequences that a subsea pipeline can have on the environment; and


