
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
By the City of Seldovia, Alaska
Project to replace and install harbor gangway roof/covering

The City of Seldovia City Council is requesting proposals from qualified contractors and businesses for the replacement and installation of the covering of the gangway approach at the Seldovia Small Boat Harbor. The successful proposer will be contracted to remove the existing, worn-out canvas covering that was severely damaged during a recent wind storm. The proposer will also replace the covering with either the same canvas material previously used or a new material depending on overall costs and expected longevity of the material. Duties include providing labor and materials to perform the removal, disposal and installation of the gangway roof.

A successful proposal will include labor costs, material types and costs, a timeline to completion, along with details surrounding the project that may require input from the Council (material type, marine grade finish, resiliency to the elements).

All bidders must submit a City of Seldovia Plan Holder's Registration form to be on the Plan Holders List and to be considered responsive. Sealed Proposals will be received by the Office of the City Clerk at 245 Dock Street, PO BOX B, Seldovia, Alaska 99663 **no later than 4:30pm, February 28, 2019**. Proposals received after the time fixed for receipt of the Proposal shall not be considered.
