RESOLUTION 19-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELDOVIA  
SUPPORTING THE REPAIR AND REOPENING OF THE ROCKY RIVER ROAD AND  
RED MOUNTAIN ROAD AND REQUESTING THAT THE ALASKA SENATE  
APPROPRIATE ENGINEERING FUNDS TO FACILITATE THOSE REPAIRS**

**Whereas**, the State of Alaska Red Mountain Road and Rocky River Road easement repair can provide new economic opportunities to the communities of the Lower Cook Inlet, and establish access to remote State and Federal park lands and historical sites; and

**Whereas**, the repair of the road will stimulate the social wellbeing of those of us who live in this remote region of Alaska, and provide all walks of life easier and more affordable access to State and Federal wilderness parks through access via 17B easements and historical mining sites; and

**Whereas**, the Red Mountain Road and Rocky River Road repair provides direct road access to remote recreational areas of the old chrome mining area a historical site and commercial fishing grounds when repaired to Picnic Harbor where fish can be off loaded and trucked to Jakolof Bay; and

**Whereas**, repaired road access would simulate recreational activities and commercial fishing support businesses on the eastside of the Kenai Peninsula; and

**Whereas**, repaired road access would stimulate recreational guide opportunities; and

**Whereas**, repair of the Red Mountain Road and Rocky River Road would stimulate existing businesses and livelihoods for lower Kenai Peninsula; and

**Whereas**, repair of the Red Mountain Road and Rocky River Road will lead to a healthier more robust and vibrant Lifestyle for remote communities of our Lower Cook Inlet region here on the tip of the Kenai Peninsula.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Seldovia supports the repair and reopening of the Red Mountain Road and the Rocky River Road and requests that the State of Alaska appropriate engineering funds to facilitate those repairs.
