

RANGE SAFETY RULES

San Juan Shooting Range

- 1. Checking in at the office is not required but appreciated. Children/teens must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.**
- 2. All range users and shooters are personally responsible for range safety and safe shooting.**
- 3. If you observe any unsafe facility condition or an unsafe shooter, report it immediately to the office.**
- 4. Shooters and observers must wear ear and eye protection. Both are available in the office.**
- 5. This is a cold range. Firearms must be carried empty. Firearms will be kept unloaded until on the firing line.**
- 6. NO MAGNUMS on the pistol steel targets. Shooters using pistols with magnum loads may use the steel gongs on Range 7 only! You will be responsible for any damage by using magnums on unauthorized targets.**
- 7. All shooting is to be into shooting bays only. Shooting will be in authorized areas. Do not walk up on the berms.**
- 8. No shooting at unauthorized targets (cans, bottles, boxes, deer, rabbits, etc.) No shooting at target frames/props.**
- 9. Deposit all trash in appropriate containers. (Paper, recycled cans, glass)**
- 10. Alcohol is prohibited on all ranges. Persons who have been consuming alcohol or are under the influence of drugs are prohibited from shooting.**
- 11. Please follow these rules while using the range. Violations will be enforced, and you may be asked to leave the facility.**

(Treat all guns as if they are loaded; always point the gun in a safe direction; keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot; be sure of your target and what is behind it.)
