His favorite dance is the one he's doing at the moment, Steve Johnson says. In fact, a good dance, he's come to realize, is not one where he manages to put his feet in the right spot every step, but one that leaves him and his partner smiling and a bit out of breath. Steve can be seen

having many of these "good ones" as he and partner Judy Furgason come off the dance floor at the Atrium, Indiana Roof, Indy Dancers, the Moose, summer dances in the park, or here at Continental Dance. In Florida, they've danced at the Bradenton Women's Club and Sara Dance Center. Wherever the location, Judy agrees, she and Steve are more interested in having fun than in technical corrections.

Judy was born in Corydon, Indiana, moving to Indianapolis at age eight. She began a career teaching first and second grade, but with three children under two, she and her husband decided to buy out her parents' wholesale distributorship, selling numismatic, philatelic, and sport card supplies to mom and pop shops across the country, later selling the business to a friendly competitor in 2006. While Judy always loved to dance, her husband had no interest. After he passed in 2008, she began dance lessons. She started with Tango, switching after a few weeks to West Coast Swing.

Steve grew up in Decatur, Illinois, earning a BS in Mechanical Engineering at Urbana. After beginning work with Eli Lilly 34 years ago, he earned an MBA from Indiana State. Today Steve is a Supplier and Service Provider Quality Auditor, visiting Lilly suppliers and service providers to confirm their operations meet Lilly's expectations. Steve started dancing a little over six years ago as "part of my conscious effort not to grow up and be a grumpy old man". At Charlotte's Indy Any Swing Goes four years ago, he met Judy.

The pair loves to travel and spend time with friends and family. Their many interests include bicycling, hiking, kayaking, working out, and Euchre. Steve loves backpacking and running. Judy, who has ridden 27,000 miles on a motorcycle, now rides an electric bike, often riding it with Steve on trails in different states.

In addition to her twin boys, Judy has three grandsons and two granddaughters ranging in age from two to 18, all in Indianapolis. Steve, who never had children, is close to his nephew, two nieces,

When COVID hit, Steve was in New Jersey on a six month assignment. Realizing things were not going to return to normal any time soon, he came back to Indiana to work from home. Judy hurried back to Indiana from Florida and the pair quarantined at Steve's place. With limited opportunities for activity, Steve underwent an ACL reconstruction and meniscus repair on his knee, while Judy had double knee replacement 20 days later. (The neighbors thought a rehab facility had moved in, Steve recalls).

Now fully back in the swing, and whether they are in Indiana or Florida, whatever dance Steve and Judy are doing - they're sure to come off the floor smiling and out of breath!
