HOLY WEEK AND EASTER

This will be a Holy Week and Easter like none other we have ever experienced. For the first time ever, we will not be holding Easter services due to the coronovirus pandemic. However, we can make this time meaningful. We can spend Holy Week reading the scriptures related to each day of Jesus' last week (see below).

On Thursday you can eat a meal with your family and afterwards, read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26, break bread and drink grape juice. If you are single, invite another single to join you on Thursday.

On Good Friday evening watch the sermon video posted at www.communitynorthbc.org

On Easter Sunday watch the Easter sermon video. Greet each person you speak to with "Christ is risen!" This affirmation will put joy in your heart and remind others of the importance of this sacred Sunday. You can also post "Christ is risen!" on your Facebook page and text it on your cell phone. Don't forget the psychological value of a human voice. Telephone a friend, family member, or church member and say, "Christ is risen!"

While the whole of Lent is a journey toward the cross with Jesus, Holy Week is where we experience this journey with the greatest intensity.

April 5 – Palm Sunday – This day commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Luke 19:28-40 **Monday, April 6** – On this day, Jesus cleansed the Temple and cursed a fig tree for not bearing fruit and cleansed the Temple. Mark 11:12-25

Tuesday, April 7 – On Tuesday of Holy Week, Jesus debated with the religious authorities in the Temple and issued his famous discourse about the end of the age on the Mount of Olives. Mark 11:27-33 and Mark 13:1-37.

Wednesday, April 8- By Wednesday, the religious leaders were conspiring to kill Jesus, and Judas had begun striking his deal of betrayal – Luke 22:1-6. Mary of Bethany anoints Jesus. Mark 14:1-9.

Thursday, April 9- Thursday is the day Jesus washed his disciples feet and instituted the Lord's Supper. After the supper, Jesus and the disciples went to the Garden of Gethsemane. John 13:1-17, 31-35

Good Friday, April 10- Jesus is tried, crucified and buried. John 18:1-19:42

Saturday, April 11- The day Jesus' body lay in the tomb. Matt 27:57-66

Easter Morning, April 12- Christ is risen! Matthew 28:1-10 **Evening-** Jesus reveals himself to "Doubting" Thomas. John 20:19-29
