MARION COUNTY BASEBALL ASSOCIATION 2019 / 2020 - BAT RULES

T-Ball Boys, Coach Pitch League, Federal League & Little League:

2019 Legal Bats:

- A. Any bat with the USSSA 1.15 BPF stamp that is 2 ¼" at the thickest part of the barrel and is 33" or less in length is to be considered a legal bat. This includes composite bats stamped USSSA 1.15 BPF as well.
- B. Any bat with the USA Baseball stamp is to be considered a legal bat. This includes the 2 5/8" barrel.
- C. P.O.I. ~ Beginning in 2020 the USSSA 1.15 BPF stamp will be illegal. All bats going forward will be required to have <u>USA Baseball</u> stamp.

Pony League:

Bats shall be 2 5/8" barrel or less with a -3 drop. Bats must have BBCOR stamp. This rule is in accordance with OHSAA rule changes (2011).

Wood bats are legal. If it is NOT one solid piece of wood, then it must meet the requirements of the BBCOR certification...including having the BBCOR stamp.

- A. P.O.I. ~ Bamboo bats with the BBCOR certification are legal.
- B. P.O.I. ~ Bamboo bats without the BBCOR certification are not legal.
- C. P.O.I. ~ Bats with metal handles and wood barrels are not legal.

T-Ball Girls, Div. D, Div. C, Div. B & Div. A:

Bats shall be stamped with either the 2000 or 2004 ASA certification mark and not be on the ASA non-approved list which can be found at www.asasoftball.com.
