Cost \$12.84. If you choose to ride the historic carousel cost is \$1.00. From the Carousel, we will travel to the Ohio State Reformatory for a 1.5 hour tour. Cost \$15.00 per person if we have 20 people going. If not \$18 for senior discount. If time allows there is a Firefighter's Museum right by the hotel (free) which we can tour before they close at 4. Check into the hotel. Leave from the hotel for dinner reservations at 5:30 at the Steve Dakota's restaurant.
