Our Snooze and Cruise this year will be to Ohio where we will tour the Ohio State Reformatory and the area around Mansfield, Ohio. Our host hotel is the Quality Inn and Suites on N. Trimble Rd. in Mansfield, Ohio. Room rate is \$99.00. Phone #419-529-1000. We now have a block of 12 rooms available for us but since there

is a race at MidOhio that weekend, I would recommend to get your reservation in early. We have 3 members going so far. When you call, use LEMOC to get the \$99.00 discount.

The tentative itenery is leaving from the Love's Truckstop in Conneaut, Ohio to travel to Mansfield, Ohio. We will arrive at the Richfield Carousel Park where we will have a box lunch waiting for us. Cost \$12.84. If you choose to ride the historic carousel cost is \$1.00. From the Carousel, we will travel to the Ohio State Reformatory for a 1.5 hour tour. Cost \$15.00 per person if we have 20 people going. If not \$18 for senior discount. If time allows there is a Firefighter's Museum right by the hotel (free) which we can tour before they close at 4. Check into the hotel. Leave from the hotel for dinner reservations at 5:30 at the Steve Dakota's restaurant. The hotel has a back yard available for us to have our after dinner beverage get together and they



approved.

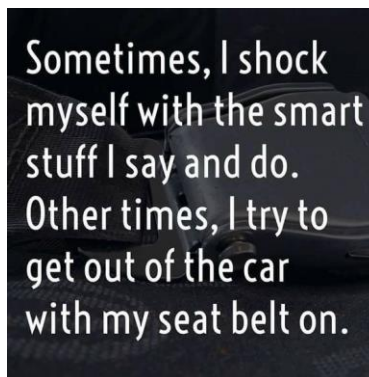

It is not a long drive. Mansfield is about 2.5 hours from Erie.
