The beginning of the process - one big jigsaw puzzle...



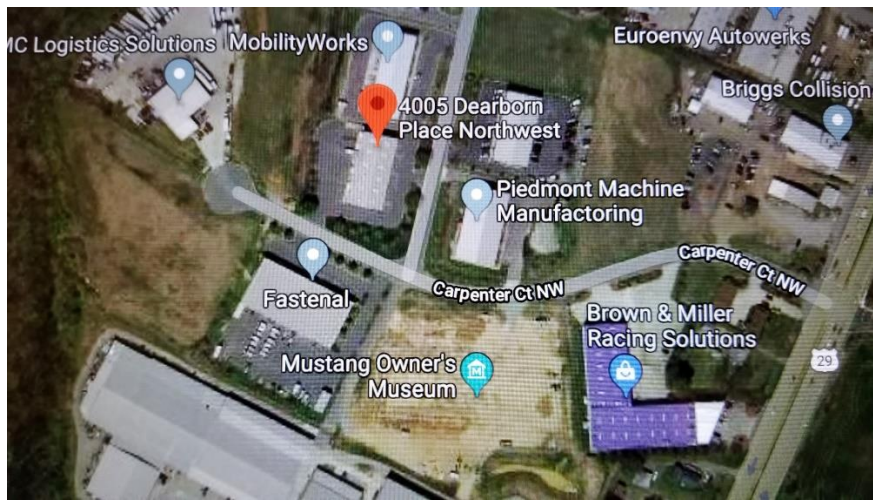
The body is attached to the frame but it doesn't look like any work is being done here....

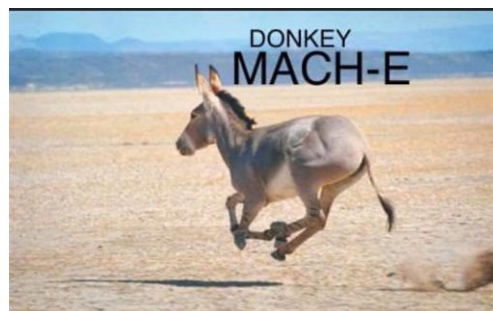
MUSTANG OWNERS MUSEUM NOTE
