DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

Lately, we have had several complaints with people illegally parking in our assigned handicap spots. Persons approved for handicap parking have a handicap permit sign which is easily seen. Our problem is with golf carts in handicap spots. We have no way to know if the person is handicapped or illegally parked (yes, it is illegal for ANY vehicle to park in a handicap spot). So, we are asking Residents with handicaps and golf carts to please stop by the Recreation Desk to obtain Handicap stickers for their golf carts (please provide proof of handicap). **Beginning Monday, February 10th, we will report any vehicles (cars, golf carts) illegally parked in handicap spaces.** These vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense and may face up to a \$250.00 Florida fine. Illegally parked vehicles may also be reported via HandicappedFraud.org. The hassle and aggravation of having your car impounded and fined is nothing compared to that of our handicapped residents who come to events and at times are forced to return home because there isn't handicap parking available. I know that we will all be more aware of this and that we will all do the right thing!

Please be sure to complete the "Recreation Department Reservation "Green Form" to book events. Reservations aren't confirmed until we have your completed form or email confirmation. Reservations are only accepted in writing for a couple of good reasons: 1) if there is a conflict or "double booking" on facilities, we, the Rec. Staff can make a "first come, first serve" determination based on the date we received the form and; 2) this helps the Rec. Dept. minimize mistakes by receiving the information in writing (form or email) from the source. We are doing our best to better serve your needs by getting accurate event information.
