Primacoustic Panel Cleaning Information

Cleaning dirt off of panels <u>might</u> be possible depending on the dirt. But first, and most important, keep in mind that you do not want to drench the panel. If you drench the engineered fiberglass under the fabric, you can kill the panel. The goal is to use only enough soap and water to dampen and clean the fabric surface of the panel. FYI, the recommendation for installed panels is to gently vacuum them.

Basically, you can use a little soap, like a liquid dishwater soap or liquid laundry soap (non-bleach) in water. Take a washcloth and dampen just a portion of it in the soap and water. Then use your fingers to gently rub the surface of the panel where the dirt is. Then use a damp washcloth with just enough water to remove any excess soap. Again, this is just a light surface cleaning of the fabric. You want to avoid getting the engineered fiberglass underneath the surface wet.

Unfortunately, water damage stains are likely permanent. The only real solution is to recover or replace a panel. The "Recovering a Panel" tutorial is with the Primacoustic information . You can use any acoustically transparent material. Or you can use the same Primacoustic fabric. The part number for Primacoustic fabric is F170-000-xx. The xx relates to color: xx= 00 = Black; xx = 03 = Beige; xx = 08 = Grey.
