Master HOA Meeting

Like the Lakes HOA a quorum was not established. The required number of residents either attending or sending in their proxies to have a quorum is 173, and only 139 were counted.

The various committees submitted their reports. The Welcome Committee reported that 38 new residents were visited and welcomed. The Newsletter reported that they turned over to the Master Board \$5,900 for 2019, proceeds from the advertisers. The Clubhouse Committee who checks the condition of the clubhouse after it has been rented out reported and said they need volunteers. (see article). The irrigation committee, of one, Aldo Marino, reported that there are many problems that need to have professional attention which have been reported to the Master Board. Aldo checks the irrigation system for the entire community every month and fixes what he can and reports major concerns to the Master Board.

Some of the many improvements made by the Master HOA include, pressure washing common areas, cleaning up over growth in those areas, tree trimming, pickle ball lighting improved, fully funding the reserve account, various concrete projects completed, entry way electrical problems hopefully repaired and last by not least the rehab of the bathrooms at the pool.

At the organizational meeting following Jeff Dongilli was appointed as a new board member and PJ Doyle stepped down after several years of service.

The ARC's recommendation for storm shutter guidelines was approved.
