

Sending your child to Camp Wiregrass is a great decision!

Helpful Information - PLEASE PRINT AND KEEP THIS INFORMATION AS YOUR GUIDE

DEPOSITS: Each camper registration requires a \$15 deposit and a small convenience fee. The deposit (\$15) Is subtracted from the tuition amount and the balance is due at check-in. We accept cash or checks at check-in desk. **DEPOSITS ARE NONREFUNDABLE**.

CHECK-IN: PLEASE NOTICE: Check-in TIME on SUNDAY AFTERNOONS from 3:00-4:30 PM.

THE safety and security of your child is a prime concern of ours, therefore, no early check-ins are allowed. When you arrive, please go directly to the dining hall where check-in takes place. Once you have completed the check-in process, take your child to the assigned cabin where our cabin leaders and counselors will be ready to meet and assist you in getting your child set.

Again, hours for check-in are now from 3:00-4:30 PM. NO EARLY CHECK-INS.

PICK-UP: Always on Friday. Please ask about pick-up time when checking your child in as each director sets pick-up time for his week of camp. IMPORTANT – Each Parent/guardian is required to come to the office and sign his/her child out before leaving camp! Written permission should be given at check-in time if the child is to be pick up by anyone else. Whoever picks up the child must come to the office and sign child out BEFORE leaving campus.

MEDICATION: All medications must be in prescription bottles with doctor's information and orders (NO PILL ORGANIZERS). Medications will be received by the nurse or her assistant at the check-in desk. Be sure to see the nurse/assistant before leaving if your camper has any medications or health conditions.

INSURANCE: Our camper application now requires applicants to list their health insurance provider's name, policy number and group number. By doing this, a copy of the health insurance card is no longer needed. If that information does change before your child comes to camp, however, a copy of the new health card **must be presented** at the check-in desk.

GPS/DRIVING ADDRESS: The physical address for the camp is: 264 Wiregrass Road- Chancellor,
Alabama 36316. Look for the blue water tower on State Highway 27 in
Chancellor, take County Road 22 (aka- Campbell Hill Road) for about 1.5 miles
down to the Camp Wiregrass drive on the left. When relying on GPS or other
navigation systems, use with caution; do not be led onto any dirt roads
near the camp as some become dangerous and almost impassable during rainy
weather. Please phone us at 334-684-2118 if you become lost.

MAILING ADDRESS: Mail must be sent to our P.O. Box as no mail is delivered to the physical address.

Mailing address is: P.O. Box 311072 – Enterprise, AL 36331. Be sure the camper's Name is on the piece along with a return address. NO LARGE OR HEAVY ITEMS ACCEPTED (must fit in one hand). Remember to mail early.

SNACKS & CRAFTS: Please note that the tuition you pay *includes* an allotment for snacks and crafts. We **do not** advise parents to leave extra money with campers as it may be lost.

T-SHIRTS: T-shirts will be on sale inside the DINING HALL at check-in and inside the office at other times. T-shirts are not included in camper tuition.

THINGS TO BRING TO CAMP

<u>CLOTHING:</u> All clothing must be modest, not tight fitting, <u>with hemlines approximately two inches above the knee</u>, all waistlines covered, only clean wording/graphics, and <u>shoes are to be worn always</u>. Please include two pair of jeans for hiking and a pair of athletic shoes. There will be a banquet night but attire is not formal.

Suggestions for daily wear:

<u>For Boys:</u> shorts, jeans, t-shirts, pullover shirts, <u>Fo</u>

Croc-type shoes, sandals, athletic shoes, swimsuit

(For banquet – casual pants with pullover shirt

For the pool – swimsuit & t-shirt cover)

For Girls: modest shorts or capris, jeans, t-shirt, tops

fully covering the tummy, sandals, athletic shoes,

(For banquet – casual skirts/tops, casual dresses)

For the pool – swimsuit & cover-up)
