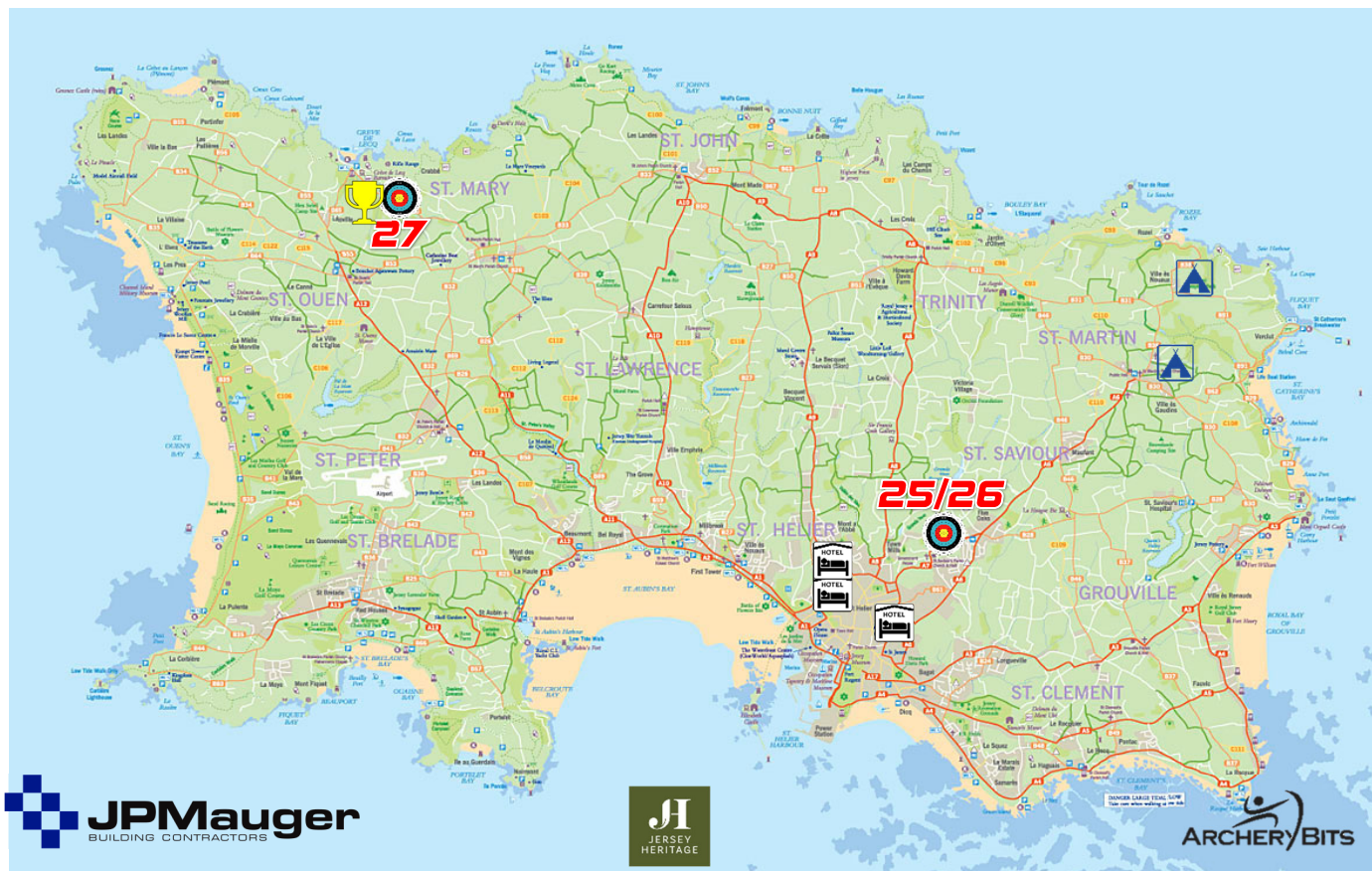

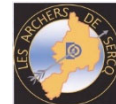

- Rounds** Saturday WA 720 70m; 60m; 50m VI 720 rounds Individual Head 2 Head match play
Sunday WA 1440 90m, WA1440 70m VIR2 rounds + Metrics for Juniors
Monday Big Game 3d round – Trophies for barebow and longbow only
- Judges** Mr N Nicholson, Mr P Collins, Mr P Richards, Mrs Julie Coates
- Registration, bow inspection** Registration from 08:15 both days. Archery GB membership cards must be available and shown on request. Equipment inspection will be carried out prior to start of practice.
- Awards** Perpetual and Inter-insular awards will continue to be awarded but will not leave the Channel Islands. WA720/WA1440 will be awarded to Barebow, Longbow, ladies Recurve, Gentlemen's Recurve, Junior Recurve, Ladies Compound, Gentlemen's Compound. H2H Barebow and Longbow will compete together dependant on enrolled numbers. 3d Rounds whilst all disciplines will be allowed to shoot only Barebow and Longbow will medal.
The overall winners of each shooting category will be decided on a points based system, combining the results of the 3 WA rounds with 1 point of for 1st, 2 for 2nd etc., Any ties will be resolved using scores from the 1440 rounds. Novice archers may shoot a shorter round, but will not be eligible for awards.
Archers shooting the WA 1440 [gents and ladies] are eligible for WA star, Silver Star, English Cross awards available for archers shooting the relevant rounds.
- Entry fees** Adult Residents £17.50 per day or £45.00 for all three; Juniors £10.00 per day or £25.00 for all three. Target list will be populated on a **PAID ONLY** first come first served basis until filled, or our closing date 12 May 2019. Refunds only available for cancellation prior to 28 April 2019.

Registration from 08:30 Inspection 08:45 Practice 09:15 Rounds start at 10:00
- Format** WA 720,70m / 60m round for recurve, barebow and longbow full 122cm faces
WA 720, 50m for compound, on 6 ring 80cm faces
Juniors and cadets will shoot their longest Metric distance full 122cm faces
Barebow and Longbow will be classed together for the H2H [pending review]
WA1440 Compound archers shooting the 90m, 70m and 60m rounds will shoot individual 6 ring faces in ends of 6 arrows at the two shorter distances.
WA1440 Recurve, barebow, longbow and Metric archers will shoot an 80cm full face in ends of 6 arrows at the two shorter distances.
VI 720 and VIR2 Rounds will be run on a limited boss basis dependant on entry.
- Shooting Rules** This tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time of the event. Archers competing at record status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Noncompliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign relevant box on entry form giving consent for their junior archers [under 18] to be tested if approached.

- Smoking** Would archers kindly note that smoking [including the use of E cigarettes] is only allowed behind the Pavilion or in the designated area at the JAS clubhouse. Persistent offenders will be warned and may be excluded from the tournament. Entry to the tournament is considered as acceptance of this policy.
- Photography** In line with Archery GB policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the tournament organiser. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
- Refreshments** A selection of snacks and drinks will be available throughout the weekend. Filled rolls will be on sale Saturday and Sunday during event
Sunday Awards BBQ at Crabbe Club House £15.00/head for food, bring your own drinks inform in advance of any allergy, vegetarian or gluten intolerance.

- Raffle** Tickets available throughout the weekend and drawn at Sunday BBQ.
- Dress code** As this is a record status shoot, Archery GB rule 307 for dress codes will apply.

Monday parking is restricted from the range but available within the Crabbe Camping Facility a short walk from the club house.

Arrows** All lost arrows are reported to the tournament organiser, during the Foresters round, pure carbon arrows should not be used as they cannot be found using metal detectors. A column is included on the Foresters score sheet to record lost arrow colours and details at the relevant target.
