¹ Now the first agreement [covenant] had regulations for service* and the earthly holy place. ² For in the first section of a tent that was prepared, called holy, were the lampstand, the table and the presentation of the loaves. ³ But after the second curtain was a section of a tent called a Holy of Holies. ⁴ It contained a golden altar of incense and the ark of the agreement [covenant]

covered on all sides with gold. In it was a golden jar containing the manna, the rod of Aaron that budded and the tablets of the agreement [covenant].

Above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the seat of absolution*. We cannot speak in detail of these things at this time.

Once these things are prepared in such a way, all the priests enter the first section of the tent as they perform their duties.
But once a year, only the high priest enters the second section, and not without blood which he

⁸ By that the Holy Spirit is signifying, that the way of the holy *places* was not to be revealed* while the first section of a tent is still in place.

⁹ It is a parable* concerning the present time. When the gifts and sacrifices were offered they were not able to satisfy the conscience of the one serving. ¹⁰ They deal only with foods and drinks, various washings and

regulations for the body. These are imposed until a time of restoration* comes.

- **8 to be revealed** -(edm) perfect passive infinitive.

- ¹¹ But Christ is a High Priest of the good *things* that have come. He came through the greater and perfect* Tent not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.
- ¹² He entered the holy places not through a blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood. By *doing so* He acquired an ever-present redemption.
- ¹³ For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a young cow* sprinkled on those who are unclean, purifies the flesh as clean, ¹⁴ how much more will the blood of Christ, who through *His* ever-present spirit* offered himself faultless* to GOD [Trinity], cleanse our conscience away from dead works in order to serve the living GOD [Trinity]?
- ¹⁵ And because of this, He is the mediator of a new agreement [covenant] through death that has taken place, which is for the release through ransom* for the violations committed under the first agreement [covenant]. And those who are called may take the promise of the ever-present inheritance.

Old and New agreements are will and testaments that require death ¹⁶ Now, a purpose of a will, is to point* to a death of him who made *the will*. ¹⁷ A will is in force* over those who died. It has no power* if the one who made the will is alive.

¹⁸ Therefore the first agreement [covenant] was not dedicated without blood. ¹⁹ When every commandment of the Law had been spoken by Moses to all the people, he took the blood of the calves and goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop and sprinkled both the scroll and all the people. ²⁰ He was saying, "This is the

blood of the agreement [covenant] that GOD [Trinity] commanded to you. ²¹ And in the same way he also sprinkled with the blood the tent and all the utensils for service.

²² According to the Law, almost everything is purified with blood. Apart from the shedding of blood there is no release *of sins*.

²³ Therefore it was necessary for the pattern of the heavenly things to be cleansed with these. But the things that are in Heaven, in themselves are better sacrifices than these.

²⁴ For Christ did not enter holy *places* made by hands, which are a pattern of true things, but into the Heaven itself, where He presently is before GOD [*Trinity*] on our behalf.

²⁵ He did not need to offer Himself repeatedly, similar to the high priest who enters the holy *places* every year with blood that is not his own. ²⁶ For He would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world.

But now He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages for the removal of sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

Christ will take up His Church secretly at His 2nd Coming ²⁷ And it is reserved to men once to die, and then, Judgment. ²⁸ So it is also with the Christ. He was offered once to bear the sins of many *and* for the second *time* He will be seen* by those who *stay* away from sin *and* await Him for salvation*.

28 - will be seen – (edm) this refers to a secret rapture of church. But only those who stay away from sin will see him. At the 2^{nd} Coming every eye will see him. Secret rapture takes place just before the 2^{nd} coming as part of one common event because of the term 'second time'; (Thayer) 3700 to allow one's self to be seen; (edm) future passive.

28 - He will be seen by those who stay away from sin and await him for salvation - (*edm*) apart/separate 5565 from sin 266 he will be seen 3700 to 1519 those 846 awating 553 deliverance 4991.
