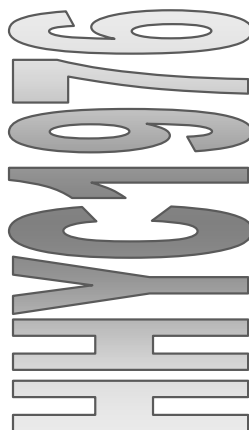


### Non Hosted Events for 2019
