

Pinal County officials have canceled the past two meetings in which RV issues were to be discussed. Therefore, the March 11, 2015 meeting at 9 am is really important for everyone to show up to provide support for our citizen's committee representative, Rich Wist. He has been given special permission to address the Board of Supervisors at this Supervisor work session. (Public comment is normally not allowed at such a session.) For each of the five County Supervisors, we have made up a notebook with all our points listed so the Supervisors can both hear our message and see in written format how the county has taken several ordinances out-of-context when drafting the new RV rules. (The information that you have received as individual emails is included in these Supervisor notebooks.) As far as we know no one else will be addressing the Supervisors. Your presence will really make a point that when considering "Short term RV Guest Housing" we want 1) no set-back restrictions and 2) removal of the "two occupied RVs makes an RV Park". We believe that we have the foundations to support both those goals. We also think that unless the Supervisors pass our draft (which is unlikely) the RV short term guest housing issue will be put off until fall of 2015 with a final decision in the spring of 2016. Should this RV issue continue unresolved, we will be asking the Supervisors to postpone any enforcement of the "two occupied RVs equal an RV Park". We encourage you to bring your interested friends and car pool to Florence next Wed. Our Canadian friends, realtors and all interested parties need to show their support!
