Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form.

If the dog needs to be measured it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running, either by the judge of record or by a VMO or AKC rep if present.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Deaf dogs are eligible to participate.

Females in season shall not be eligible to participate. Entry fees for females in season must be refunded per Chapter 1, Section 9.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. **When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.**

For Exhibition Only (FEO) will be allowed in FAST and T2B at this trial. Please refer to Chapter 5, Section 7 of the AKC rule book regarding rules for FEO.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

EQUIPMENT: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. All jumps will be displaceable.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class, following the judges briefing. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up area consisting of one regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up areas to relieve their dogs

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each jump height in each class. Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. In addition, each entered dog will receive a prize or toy to be determined by the Trial committee. The Club also gives "New Title" Rosettes, "AGCH", "MACH", & "PACH" Bars & Rosettes and Double & Triple Q Ribbons.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited in the trial area. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group, if they wish.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Five Flags Dog Training Club, Inc, its agents, etc., assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

***** ENTRIES ACCEPTED BY FIRST RECEIVED *****

Refunds: Entry fee will be refunded for bitches who come in season after the close of the trial and entry fee minus **\$5.00 per run entered** will be refunded dogs injured & unable to compete. In either case, the Trial Secretary must receive [written certification from a veterinarian](#) no later than 8:00AM day of trial for a refund to be issued. Withdrawals after closing will be refunded in full if their slot is filled from the waitlist (see below). Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Waitlist: Should a waitlist become necessary, the club may fill cancellations after closing with these entries until Wednesday, November 17th at 12:00pm. Waitlist will be limited to 30 runs.

MOVE UPS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail accepted) no later than Monday November 22, 2021 at 12:00PM. For Sat/Sun move-ups, the request must be made to the Trial Secretary in writing prior to the close of Fri/Sat's event.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VENDORS

Space is limited, so contact us soon if you'd like to set up at our trial. A 10 X 10 space is \$53.75 per day (\$43 w/o electricity). A 10 X 20 is \$107.50 per day (\$86 w/o electricity). Or you may rent a stall (see next page for prices on stalls).

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. Please observe the "No Crating" signs and no crates within 10 feet of the ring gating. Crates may be left overnight; however, FFDTTC and the Escambia County Equestrian Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

IMPORTANT: THERE IS NO CRATING ALLOWED IN THE BLEACHERS PER THE FIRE MARSHALL.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

FROM WEST: I-10 TO Exit 5 (right on Nine Mile Road (Alternate 90) to Beulah Rd, (2.8 miles to second light), left on Beulah Rd to Mobile Hwy (Hwy 90) (1.1 miles to stop sign), left on Mobile Hwy to Arena on the left (.7 miles). **There are no hotels at this exit. Proceed to exit 10AB or exit 13 for hotels.**

FROM EAST: I-10 TO exit 7, left on Pine Forest Road (2.2 miles) to Blue Angel Parkway, right on Blue Angel (.5 miles) to Mobile Hwy (Hwy 90), right on Mobile Hwy (3.8 miles) to the arena on the right.



PARKING AT THE ARENA: There is ample exhibitor parking in the large field just north of the arena. There is **NO PARKING** in the stalls, in the areas between the stalls or in the area between the arena and the stalls. You may drive into the area between the arena and the stalls to unload **prior to the start of the event**, however, you may not leave your vehicle in that area. **Please observe all NO PARKING signs.**

STALL RENTALS: There are 292 12' X 12' wooden stalls with grilled sliding door front panels. Rental includes lights, water, and electrical hookups. They are located adjacent to the arena. They are lockable and are large enough to share with a friend. **Bring your own lock & chain.** 1 Day-\$18.28, 2 Days-\$30.10, 3 Days-\$41.93, 4 Days-\$53.75, 5-7 Days-\$69.88, payable to Escambia County.

Rental is \$18 per day + tax (\$20.07 total) & includes water, electrical hookups and use of shower & restroom facilities.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
