If the dog needs to be measured it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running, either by the judge of record or by a VMO or AKC rep if present.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Deaf dogs are eligible to participate.

Females in season shall not be eligible to participate. Entry fees for females in season must be refunded per Chapter 1, Section 9.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) will be allowed in all classes at this trial. Please refer to Chapter 5, Section 7 of the AKC rule book regarding rules for FEO.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

EQUIPMENT: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. All jumps will be displaceable.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class, following the judges briefing. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up area consisting of one regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up areas to relieve their dogs

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each jump height in each class. Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. In addition, each entered dog will receive a prize or toy to be determined by the Trial committee. The Club also gives "New Title" Ribbons, "AGCH", "MACH", & "PACH" Bars & Rosettes and Double & Triple Q Ribbons.
