



## Garbage & Recycling Pick Up

**Garbage pick-up is once a week on Sunday/Monday during the WINTER months and twice a week on Sunday/Monday & Thursday during the SUMMER months.**

**Residents are to ensure their household garbage bags are tear-free and secured in an animal proof garbage can or garbage stand. Animal waste or open bags will not be picked up.**

**The municipal landfill is available for residents to dispose of waste. Please pick up your dump tag to place on your vehicle review mirror from the Village Office and use the appropriately marked areas in the landfill for disposal of waste. Contractor materials require a dump permit purchased from the Village Office.**

### **Recycling Info**

**Recycling pick-up is done weekly on Tuesdays.**

**Please place recyclable items in a clear, blue, or see-through colored bag and place **BESIDE** your garbage can or stand. Items do not have to be sorted or have labels removed.**

#### Recyclable Items

- Newspaper
- Magazines, catalogues(shiny paper)
- Phone books, books
- Shredded office paper(in separate bag)
- Boxboard ie: cereal boxes
- Batteries(except automotive)

**The following should not be drippy, sticky or gooey:**

- Plastic containers - #1(PETE) unless you can't see through it, #2(HDPE), #3(PVC), #4(LDPE), #5(PP), #7 other
- Aluminium cans
- Glass bottles or jars(remove lids)
- Tin cans
- Paint and Fluorescent bulbs can be brought to the Recycling Center for safe disposal.

#### Non-Recyclable Items

- Kleenex, paper towels
- Plastic bags, plastic wrap
- Styrofoam
- Disposable plates, coffee cups etc...
- Aluminium foil, aluminium foil pans
- Lids (unless they are plastic with a recycling number)
- Construction paper, art projects, laminated paper
- #6 (PS) plastic containers
- Box liners such as cereal boxes or cracker boxes
- Chip bags, candy wrappers etc...
- Mixed material such as tin and cardboard coffee cans, padded or foil lined envelopes.
- Items with food, oils paint on them
- Glass dishes, windows, mirrors etc...
