Needle Dispensary Units are now in place in the following locations in Denare Beach please use these locations if you find a needle:

- Corner of Amisk and 9th Ave - By Band Office

- Alley by Denareplex - Sand Bar - By Water Treatment Plant - Main Beach

-Bulletin Sign at Corner of Moody & 10th

If you find a needle

-Wear garden, medical or work gloves.

-Use tweezers, pilers, or tongs to pick up by the end that is NOT sharp. Keep away from your body.

-Place the needle, sharp end first into the disposal unit or pop bottle with secure lid and dispose of in Dispensary. -Wash your hands with soap and water.

Now that the snow is melting, please have the conversation with your children not to touch needles and to tell an adult if they find one.

A Message from our Mayor:



Dear Residents of Denare Beach,

You will be aware that on December 31, 2019 a new strain of Coronavirus was identified in China on March 13, 2020 the World Health Organization declared the COVID-19 to be a Pandemic and it continues to be a Public Health Emergency of international concern.

On March 12, 2020 the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health's Provincial Medical Health Officer declared that Saskatchewan now had its first presumptive case of COVID-19 being identified on March 14, 2020. To this date the numbers of cases in Saskatchewan have continued to increase. The media continues to update the statistics of confirmed and presumptive positive cases, along with case surveillance and testing information.

The Government of Saskatchewan declared a Provincial State of Emergency on March 18, 2020 as part of the scope of the Provincial declaration, every Saskatchewan municipality is now under a state of emergency, including Denare Beach. Please ensure your safety and for others by engaging, simple contact precautions. This includes keeping a minimum distance of 2 meters (6 feet) from others, avoid touching your face, mouth, nose and eyes. Wash your hands with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds several times through out the day. Alcohol based sanitizer is a secondary option when soap and water are not available. In some cases, wearing gloves may be appropriate. Community members who have returned from outside of Canada will be required by law to self-isolate for a minimum of 14 days in your homes. The self-isolation period also includes monitoring health symptoms and calling Healthline 811 should any symptoms of concern arise. Anyone who has been in afflicted with or in contact with someone afflicted with COVID -19 will also be required to self-isolate in your home and monitor your health symptoms for 14 days.

Denare Beach employees are considered an essential to the operation of our community needs. Their health is a paramount consideration to ensure delivery of municipal services that are essential to the community, sewer, water, fire, solid waste, roads and Administration. To meet this requirement, we have met provincial requirements by shutting down our recreation which includes the Denareplex, Weight room, playgrounds, hockey bunk and beaches. The Administration building is closed to the public to reduce contact and prevent illness. A locked box adjacent to the outside door will receive payments for services which can be arranged by calling (306)362-2054, faxing (306)362-2257, or e-mail denarebeach@sasktel.net. Similar practices have been employed throughout the Province as part of the emergency plan. This may be inconvenient, however, necessary to ensure the health and safety of our employees and all residents. In this time of a Health emergency our staff are trained operators of our infrastructure and competent in-service delivery which is paramount to get through this difficult time. Please do not try to visit our staff members as they are required to be fit for work.
