Registration Information

1. **Go ONLINE** and make a reservation *As Soon As Possible*.
2. A 50% deposit will be due June 5th. *LaDonna will be in contact with you after your reservation is received.*
3. Have parents fill out the **Camper Application** and bring it with you to camp.
4. Total camp cost **balance** is due at Registration on the first day of camp.

Arrival & Departure

Registration & Check In begins at 1pm and closes at 3pm.
Departure for all camps will be 11am.

Bunking Arrangements

Campers are bunked by church groups.. *Individual campers are bunked in a private dorm.*
There are a total of 6 cabins with 10 – 14 beds in each cabin.
Each cabin has 2 private showers and 2 private toilets.
Campers must bring their own bedding (sheets, sleeping bag, pillow, etc.) and towels.

Chapel Services

We have a morning meeting & devotion, an after lunch session, and an evening service.
Mandatory attendance for all campers.

Activities

- Campers will be involved in a variety of activities including team building exercises, arts & crafts projects, competitive activities, etc.
- Campers will have an option of participating in which elective they want.
- Electives include: basketball, kickball, volleyball, flag football, tug-o-war, obstacle course, gaga pit, water play, swimming, dance, drama, painting, archery, horseback riding, etc.

Food

- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner is provided.
- There will be a snack shack available at various times.
- Snack shack items cost money.
- Lunch will NOT be served on check in/out day.

Supervision

- The camp is staffed with a professional director, food service personnel, trained speakers, a medical team, & 24 hour security.
- An adult sponsor or camp staff accompanies campers at all times.
- Adult staff have 2 personal references, background check, and is carefully screened.

Adult Sponsors

- Adult Sponsors can participate in activities with the campers, but are not required to do so.
- One Sponsor should be sent per 11 campers (male and female).
- Adult Sponsors pay a reduced rate of \$100.
- Sponsors must meet the minimum age requirement of 21 years of age. (call for exceptions)
- Sponsors are housed in the dorms with their group.
- Adult Sponsors will administer all medications to their campers.
- **Adult Sponsors must have a background check (good for 5 yrs) paid for by their church.**

Rules

- Don't make a problem. (A rule Captain came up with while teaching for 10yrs).
- Strive to display Christian Character at all times.
- Destruction of property is not tolerated and those responsible will pay for damages.
- No sneaking out.
- No two male and female are to be alone. Stay in at least a group of 3.

Discipline

First time – Warning.

Second time – Adult Sponsor Informed.

Third time – Sent to the Camp Director.

Continued disobedience may result in dismissal from camp.

Medication Policy:

- Prescription medications need to be in the original bottle, with only the amount needed for the camper's stay at camp. All inhalers, nasal sprays, and epipens must be in prescription box with label and must NOT be expired. All prescription bottles should come in a Ziploc bag.

Lost & Found:

1. Don't make a problem. (A rule Captain came up with while teaching for 10yrs.)
2. Strive to display Christian Character at all times.
3. The dress attire applies to campers, counselors, and invited guests. Modest dress of all campers is to be worn as designated by the camp director and counselors.
4. Smoking or use of tobacco in any form, profanity, alcoholic beverages or drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor.) are not allowed on campgrounds at any time.
5. Campers must attend all services.
6. At service time, no one will be permitted to return to their dorm unless accompanied by an adult.
7. Campers will not be allowed to leave camp unless authorized by camp director.
8. Campers are responsible for keeping their dorms clean at all times.
9. Only bottled water will be permitted in the dorms.
10. All campers must be in their dorms at lights out.
11. No sneaking out.
12. Boys will not be allowed in girl's dorm area at any time & girls will not be allowed in boy's dorm area.
13. No two male and female are to be alone. Stay in at least a group of 3.
14. Destruction of property is not tolerated and those responsible will pay for damages.
15. Rules for acceptance and participation in the program are the same for everyone without regard to handicap, race, color, or national origin.
