# TEN COMMANDMENTS OF MUZZLELOADING

- 1. Always treat every gun as if it is loaded.
- 2. Use only black powder or replica black powder.
- 3. Be sure of your target before firing.
- Be sure the ball is firmly seated on the powder charge before you pull the Trigger.
- Treat a misfire or failure to fire with extreme care; keep muzzle pointed down range
- 6. Make sure your gun is unloaded before you store it.
- 7. Always store the gun, powder and caps in separate places.
- Never climb or jump fences or other obstructions with a loaded gun in your hand.
- 9. Protect your eyes and ears while shooting.
- Never drink alcoholic beverages prior to or during shooting and never smoke while loading, shooting or handling black powder propellants
