"SEMINARY HOUSE": \$7,000

Near Cranmer Theological Seminary is a house currently rented for Archdeacon Alexei and his family. Purchasing this home provides Bishop Willians, the seminary, and the diocese with immediate, professional, and godly assistance and potentially another house church. The first \$5,000 of the \$12,000 purchase has already been donated!

COVID RELIEF: \$20,000

REC Cuban clergy faithfully care for their flocks, but like most Cubans, receive only \$50 per month in addition to government ration cards. With salary supplements—especially needed this year as COVID relief-clergy can apply themselves far more fully to needed pastoral work. The BFM has partnered with our Canadian friends in the Anglican Network in Canada to provide \$45,000 of an annual \$70,000 budget for the diocese. More than half has already been raised this year. Will you partner to provide the balance as your Advent Offering?
