PEAK OF PERFECTION (75 pts)	66	74	70
FORM (20)	Plant heavy but unbalanced from side to side -3;	Radially symmetrical plant with even leaves; stems wiry but hanging gracefully and uniformly	Plant lopsided in pot -4; leaves bilaterally symmetrical, stems curving
COLOR (20)	Yellow-green leaves and stems, but with obvious dots/pricks of off-yellow color affecting uniformity -3; brown leaf margins on several leaves -1	Chartreuse green with an overtone of gray/white; stems uniformly pale green.	Dark grass green consistent with lighter yellow-green stems
MATURITY/SIZE (20)	Thyme thick with leaves and stems indicating appropriate age; 15" irregular by 7"	Dense, evidence of new growth; 11" round plant	Plant full in container with tight internodes; 12" irregularly round
CONDITION/BLEMISHES (15)	Turgid; leaves with pinprick damage and minor brown edges -2	Water-filled leaves, plump; minor nicks on some stems -1	Hydrated; minor browning of some stems in center of plant -1
GROOMING/STAGING (15 pts)	10	12	12
GROOMING (10)	Debris visible in center of container -2	Clean, minor debris	Dead leaves present on inner plant -1; one-side plant could have been trained -2
STAGING (5)	Obvious plant marker on side of container -3	Label on container not removed -3	Clean container and centered
